Searching

Search Book Catalog -- Books are only mailed within US to WCIU mentors and students

Enter field(s) to search, select the checkbox for an exact phrase match:

Enter your search term in the appropriate box. If you want an exact phrase (e.g. “international development”), click in the small box to the right of the search term box. If you do not click in the small box for an exact phrase, the computer will search for records that have either of the terms in it.

At the bottom of the screen, click on Search.

Keywords

The keywords field should be used in conjunction with other fields if you wish to narrow your search results. For example, try using one term in the Keyword field and a second term in the Subjects or Title fields to refine your search.

Searching for E-Books

If you want to find electronic books, enter your search terms as usual (such as searching in the Keywords field).

Then in the Location field type “web” and click on the Search button.

Many of our electronic books are available only to our students and require passwords. But increasingly we have books that anyone may access. To find these books, in the Location field type “open” instead of “web.”

Browsing

If you find a title of interest, one way to “browse” for similar titles is to locate the call number of the title you are interested in, then select and copy the first letters and numbers located before the decimal point.

Browsing (cont'd)

Next, paste the letters and numbers from the call number into the Call Number field on the search screen.

Your search results will include all titles that begin with this section.

You can also browse by searching in nearby sections (in this example, changing the search term to HC 80 or HC 78)

No Results

If you searched for a title and the search found 0 matches, first check your typing or spelling. If they are correct, try searching for the author or a keyword. Sometimes using a different search approach will find records that are otherwise not found.

Some keywords (or subjects) may be too specific. Choose a more general search term and try again.

If you still receive no matches, try again at a later date. We are still electronically cataloging our print collection, and we are periodically adding electronic books.

Search Results

The number of matches will be listed at the top of the window, and only 10 are displayed on a page. To see more, click on “Next” at the bottom of the page.

Most of our books are in print. These are only mailed out within the U.S. to WCIU mentors and students. If you live in our local area, you may read them in our library or borrow them if you are a registered student or WCIU mentor. Others may borrow books under special conditions.

In the search results, electronic books (or e-books) will display a link to the book so you may read it on your computer. Click on the link, and you will either be asked for a user name and password or, for open access books, it will take you directly to the book or a cover page for accessing the book.

Requesting Books

If you wish to have a book mailed to you:

- Fill in your name and email address in the boxes before the list of results.
- Click in the small box to the left of “Title” if you want to borrow that particular book.
- When you move to another page, the titles you have checked will all be listed before the results.
